## **Humane World for Animals Events Terms and Conditions**

These Terms and Conditions (“Terms”), along with the Code of Conduct (“Code”), apply to any person, guest, registrant, student, speaker, vendor, sponsor or exhibitor (“Participant”) who is present, whether in person, virtually, or by any other medium, at any meeting, conference, or event (“Event”) of Humane World for Animals (Humane World). By attending Event, Participant will be deemed to have accepted these Terms and the Code.

### **Modification of Program**

Humane World reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to make any changes to the program. Every effort will be made to keep presentations and speakers as represented. However, unforeseen circumstances may result in the substitution of one or more presentation topic(s) or speaker(s). Humane World is not liable for changes in program date, content, speakers or venue.

### **Cancellation by Participant**

*Through March 22, 2027:* Should a Participant wish to cancel his or her registration, registration fees are refundable, minus a \$50 cancellation processing fee. Learning Labs and exhibit hall guest passes are nonrefundable.

*After March 22, 2027:* Registration fees are final and nonrefundable for cancellation by the Participant after this date.

### **Registration Transfer**

*Through April 28, 2027:* Registrations may be transferred to another individual for the same Event, provided the recipient meets the eligibility requirements for that registration type. *After April 28, 2027:* Transfer requests will be considered on a case-by-case basis and may be accommodated when possible. Please note that Humane World may not be able to fulfill all requests within this time frame. A \$25 processing fee still applies. ### **Cancellation by Humane World for Animals of the Event**

Humane World may cancel a portion of or the entire Event due to circumstances beyond Humane World’s control, including but not limited to, acts of God, government order, pandemic, disaster or other emergencies, or any other circumstances which, in Humane World’s sole discretion, make it impracticable, inadvisable, illegal or impossible for Humane World, the Event hotel(s) or venue(s), or other locations of Event to provide the facilities and/or services for Event. Participant registration may be cancelled for any one or more of such reasons by emailed notice from Humane World to the Participant. In the event of any cancellation by

Humane World, Humane World will not be held liable to Participant(s) for any damages, losses or costs incurred, including but not limited to transportation and accommodation costs.

### **Disclaimer of Warranties and Limitation of Liabilities**

Humane World makes no representations or warranties of any kind, express or implied, as to the operation of the livestream event platform. Participant expressly agrees that your use of the livestream is at your sole risk. Humane World will not be liable for any failure of the livestream or any damages of any kind arising from the use of this livestream, including, but not limited to any outages that may occur during the live days of the Event.

### **Speakers, Presenters, and Vendors**

Humane World endeavors to have speakers, presenters and vendors knowledgeable in their subject areas. Views expressed and materials distributed by speakers, presenters, and vendors during Event are solely those of the speakers and not of Humane World. Humane World disclaims any and all liability arising out of Participant's reliance on any speaker's or presenter's statements or materials.

### **Photography & Filming of Participants**

Audio and video recording and photography may take place during Event. Participant hereby grants Humane World and its licensees, affiliates, employees, and representatives permission to photograph and/or record them at the Event, and distribute and publish (both now and in the future) the Participant's name, image, or voice in photographs, video and audio recordings, and electronic reproductions. I consent to and authorize, in advance, such use and waive any rights of privacy and/or publicity I may have in connection therewith.

### **Photography, Recording, and Press**

Humane World appreciates all coverage of Event. Photography, audio recordings, and video recordings are permitted for personal, non-commercial use. Prior written consent of Humane World is required for all other uses. All requests for press passes must be made in advance of Event by emailing [expo@humaneworld.org](mailto:expo@humaneworld.org). Press credentials are required for the issuance of a press pass, and Humane World requires that a copy of all published material be submitted to [expo@humaneworld.org](mailto:expo@humaneworld.org).

### **Registrant Discounts**

Discount codes may be made available throughout the year for full conference registration. These may be discounts posted on social media, sent via marketing emails, printed in publications, shared in webinars, or provided to the public or to specific groups in other ways. Discounts may also be won through contests conducted on social media or via email. Discount codes can only be applied to full conference registration and cannot be combined with any other offers or discounts, except the advance registration discount. Discounts won through contests are non-transferable and must be used by the contest winner to attend the Event. Selection of contest winners is at the sole discretion of Humane World. Speakers, sponsors, exhibitors and staff are not eligible to win contests.

A group discount is also available. Any Participants who register in a group of three or more from the same organization (using the “add group member button” on the registration summary page) will receive a discount of \$25 off each registration after the first two. This discount automatically applies at checkout and cannot be combined with any other discounts except the advance registration rate. If Participants have a discount code they would prefer to use, they should not register in a group.

Discounts without defined expiration dates are only valid for registrations made online prior to the beginning of the Event. No discount code may be used for new registrations or applied to existing registrations onsite.

### **Check Payments**

For those selecting “pay by check” when submitting your registration, you are not considered registered until we receive and deposit your check payment. If the registration price has changed since you submitted your registration (i.e. if the advance registration date has passed or a discount code you used has expired), the amount you owe is based upon the price *at the time your check is received*. We recommend reaching out to [expo@humaneworld.org](mailto:expo@humaneworld.org) to confirm your amount due if a significant amount of time has lapsed between the time you submitted your registration and the time your check is mailed.

**Your check must be received prior to April 9, 2027. If your check is not received by that date, your registration will be CANCELLED.** We cannot accept check payments onsite.

### **Badges**

Badges are required to be worn visibly on your person at all conference events, including the Expo party. If you forgot your badge in your hotel room, you will be instructed to return to your room to retrieve the badge. To reprint a lost badge, you will be required to pay a \$10 reprint fee, and a lost badge may only be reprinted one time. You must also have a valid photo ID that matches the information on the badge to qualify for a reprint. Networking event tickets (such as for the Expo Party or Welcome Social) will not be replaced for any reason.

### **Accessibility Services**

Humane World is committed to conducting Event in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and to making all reasonable arrangements that will allow participation in Event. Participants who require assistance during a Humane World event should request it by emailing [expo@humaneworld.org](mailto:expo@humaneworld.org) with any questions or for additional assistance.

### **Minor Participation**

No minors under the age of 16 (as of Event start date) will be permitted to register, attend or participate in Event. Minors between the ages of 16 and 18 are permitted to attend, provided they have a signed Minor Participation waiver on file with Event organizers and are accompanied at Event at all times by a registered parent or legal guardian.

### **Severability**

If any term or other provision of this Agreement is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, illegal or incapable of being enforced, all other terms, provisions and conditions of this Agreement shall nevertheless remain in full force and effect.

## **Disclaimer**

For virtual viewers, Humane World will provide Participant access to the Event. Participant is solely responsible for obtaining and maintaining, at Participant's own expense, all equipment needed to access the Event, including but not limited to computer equipment, Internet access, and adequate bandwidth.

## **Events Code of Conduct for Humane World for Animals**

**Humane World for Animals is dedicated to creating a safe, productive, and collaborative environment free from harassment for all Participants, including guests, speakers, sponsors, exhibitors, volunteers, vendors, and Humane World staff. We expect everyone to conduct themselves with professionalism, integrity, courtesy, and respect.**

The following behaviors are prohibited at Humane World Events:

- Illegal or disruptive behavior that interferes with the business or comfort of other attendees.
- Behavior that impedes or prevents accessibility services or requests.
- Behavior that violates any applicable laws or venue or vendor policies.
- Personal attacks and/or offensive verbal or written comments.
- Physical or verbal abuse.
- Bullying, stalking, intimidation, or threatening behavior.
- Inappropriate physical contact, sexual attention or sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, or unwelcome sexual banter.
- Discrimination or derogatory communication based on age, disability, race, ethnicity, gender, religion, sexual orientation, familial status, physical appearance, or any other basis protected by federal, state, or local laws.

Participants who are asked to stop or amend such behavior, by a moderator or any Humane World event staff, are expected to comply immediately.

Humane World reserves the right to refuse entry to or remove any party from the event at any time. Participants violating the Code of Conduct who are asked to leave the Event risk the forfeiture of any paid registration fees. All determinations are at the sole discretion of Humane World, and the decision of the leading Humane World representative will be final. Severe breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disqualification from participating in future events and/or notification of law enforcement.

This Policy applies to all Humane World meeting-related events, including in-person and virtual events and events sponsored by organizations other than Humane World but held in conjunction with Humane World, on public or private platforms.
