Saving Kittens in Partnership (SKIP)

The Humane Society of the United States, in partnership with Newborn Kitten Rescue, is pleased to offer a \$4000 funding opportunity to a nonprofit rescue to launch SKIP, a program that partners with local animal shelters to save sick, injured and underweight kittens at risk of being euthanized.

Purpose

Awarded funds are intended to support the health and developmental needs of at-risk kittens.

Eligibility

Grantee will:

- Be a small volunteer-focused rescue
- Have a mission consistent with saving sick, injured and underweight kittens
- Be a 501(c)(3) organization with a governing board of directors
- Affirm that there is no Conflict of Interest with a board member from Newborn Kitten Rescue, the National Kitten Coalition or the Humane Society of the United States
- Will sign a grant agreement assuring that grant funds will be used for the purpose outlined above.
- Will implement SKIP within a year of the grant award
- Will recognize HSUS' grant in its social media platforms
