Notice any cats with ears that look a little ... different?

This is an ear-tip, and it identifies community cats who have been sterilized.

Ear-tipping is a painless procedure, done while the cat is under anesthesia, and standard protocol in trap-neuter-return programs. The top of a tipped ear will appear square rather than pointy, providing a visual cue that spares cats the stress of being recaptured for a surgery they don't need.

They'll be healthier and safer, and you'll be doing your part to humanely reduce outdoor cat populations.
