Animal Care Expo 2022 Scholarship Information and Requirements

In-person scholarships for Animal Care Expo 2022 are made possible by the Humane Society of the United States (HSUS). Scholarships are available to BIPOC (Black, Indigenous and people of color) applicants in the United States.

Scholarships are \$1,500 and may be used to offset costs associated with meals during the conference, hotel accommodations at the Orlando World Center Marriott, travel expenses and other related expenses for attending Animal Care Expo 2022. Registration fees will be deducted from the scholarship amount awarded in the amount of \$185 for regular registration or \$235 if you would like to include a daylong Learning Lab

Scholarships are non-transferable without written permission from the Humane Society of the United States.

The approved scholarship dollar amount will be transferred electronically to the scholarship recipient's organization, or a check may be mailed.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be BIPOC (Black, Indigenous or a person of color).
- Applicants must be employed by or volunteer for a 501c3 animal shelter or rescue organization or a public animal shelter in the United States.
- Applicants must be able to attend Animal Care Expo April 19-22, 2022, in Orlando, Florida.
- You must be able to provide your organization's W-9 form, a signed grant agreement (will be provided), an IRS determination letter (for 501c3 organizations) and bank information for electronic transfer.
