In-shelter Behavior

If observations are gathered from a reliable in-home interview, this assessment will not be conducted again at the shelter. The Assessor may record observations at any time the dog recalls from the bowl of food to the Assessor, prior to completing all steps in this item. Indicate which progression the Assessor completed below. The Assessor must stop at any time aggressive behavior is observed.

- Assessor fits dog with buckle collar and leashes to 6 foot tether.
- Assessor issues a bowl of dry kibble to dog.
- Assessor walks around the dog in an arc at a 2-6 foot radius.
- Assessor engages the dog verbally, attempting to elicit a recall from the food bowl.
- Assessor offers a treat, attempting to elicit a recall from the food bowl.
- Assessor tosses a treat at a distance from the food bowl.
- Assessor removes food bowl OR allows dog to finish eating or disengage independently.
